## From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, February 13, 2022 – Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Cycle C  
EVANGELIZING IN THE DIOCESE OF PENSACOLA-TALLAHASSEE

We are so blessed to be part of such a vibrant local church. Although we Catholics are a clear minority in NW Florida (less than five percent of the population), we are mighty! The seeds for the faith were sown by the Holy Spirit before the first missionaries came to this land. The Gospel took hold and grew through the witness and the martyrdom of the native peoples and immigrants, and it continued to grow through the perseverance of our ancestors. Missionaries, religious, and laypeople came to this land from across the oceans, bringing the message of salvation with them. Over time, the Church was organized, first as a mission within the (Arch)Dioceses of Spain, Santiago (Cuba), New Orleans, Mobile (AL), and St. Augustine. Finally, in 1975, the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee was formed. From here, the Gospel will continue to go forth.

Although we must spread the Gospel everywhere, we have unique opportunities to evangelize to the many groups of people here in our diocesan boundaries. First of all, since our neighbors who are not Catholic comprise 95 percent of the population, we can say along with Jesus that, "The harvest is abundant!" (Mt 9:37) A good place to begin is by inviting everyone within our 18 counties to consider joining us in full communion with the Catholic Church. In addition, many, many people come to our area for the short- or long-term through the military or for vacations or seasonal living opportunities. We are blessed to welcome tens of thousands of students into our community every year at Florida State University, University of West Florida, Florida A&M University, and many other local colleges. Campus ministry has been and will continue to be an important point of evangelization. Finally, our brothers and sisters in the many prisons and jails in Northwest Florida look to us for support, prayer and a connection to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

This is not an exhaustive list; it is meant only to highlight the specific opportunities that we have in our diocese to spread the Good News to our neighbors.

### Questions for reflection:

- ◆ How do you demonstrate your Catholic faith in everyday actions (and not just on Sundays)?
- ◆ Can you give three examples of how you and your family participate in your parish's evangelization efforts?
- ◆ Who is someone in your parish who is effectively fulfilling the role of evangelizer besides your priest?
- ◆ When is the last time you evangelized to a family member, a friend or a stranger?
- ◆ What resources would you recommend to help others grow in their faith?
- ◆ What strategies or attitudes in your parish or other parishes in the diocese have you seen bring success in the work of evangelization?
- ◆ What are the most obvious obstacles to evangelizing in our 18 counties and bringing more people into full communion with Christ in the Catholic Church?
- ◆ What makes our 18 counties particularly fertile ground for the work of evangelization?
- ◆ "Go and make disciples of all nations ..." (Mt 28:19), how will you choose to evangelize when you leave this discussion?

## Celebrating St. Eugene's Heroes and Sheroes Reflecting the pride of *people of African descent!*



**Cora Lee Hébert Figaro** was a native of Ventress, Louisiana; located in Pointe Coupee Parish. Cora and her husband, Allison H. Figaro moved from Tuskegee, Alabama to Tallahassee, Florida. Allison joined the faculty of Florida A&M University as an instructor teaching classes in Physical Education. Cora and Allison had three children, Deborah, Mark, and Rita.

To her extended family she was known as "Nena", here at St. Eugene, she was lovingly called "Mama" Cora.

By any name Cora was the embodiment of grace, faith, and strength. She had many wonderful traits not the least of which was the kindness of word and deeds she bestowed upon everyone she met.

Cora was a highly talented tailor and cook. Yes, she served on the hospitality committee and provided delicious baked treats on numerous occasions. However, her service to St. Eugene was varied and influential.

Cora was one of a small band of members who fought to keep St. Eugene Chapel and Student Center a viable church in Tallahassee's Catholic community. When St Eugene did not have a priest, the person entrusted with the keys to St. Eugene was Cora Figaro.

Cora and Allison, along with other African-American Catholics who lived on the South side of Tallahassee took on the responsibility of the physical maintenance of St. Eugene. Cora was a key player in the reopening of St. Eugene in October of 1990. Mama Cora, worked behind the scenes, actively notifying former members, and recruited new members to come to the reopened catholic church on the highest of seven hills, St Eugene.

Mama Cora passed on March 8, 2014, at the age of 93.

Cora Lee Hébert Figaro is remembered not only for her gentility of spirit and her generosity, but for her faith that was strong and unshakable.



**Naomi Shakaminama (Minu) Shamatutu** was born on January 25, 1960, in Mukulaikwa Village in Zambia. She is the sixth child of her biological parents, Enoch Shamatutu and Elizabeth Lucheta, who both went on to have other children following their divorce. She was raised by her father and stepmother, Catherine Shamatutu, along with her five younger siblings from this union.

Naomi was raised Methodist and converted to Catholicism while attending Ibenga Girls Secondary School. She attended the University of Zambia, where she earned her bachelor's degree. Upon graduation, she worked for the Bank of Zambia where after six years, was awarded a USAID scholarship to study for her master's degree. She came to Tallahassee in 1988 to attend the Florida Agricultural & Mechanical University where she eventually earned her MBA. While at FAMU, she initially attended St. Thomas More until she moved to Polkinghorne Village and discovered St. Eugene and has been an active member ever since.

In 1 Peter 4:10-11 it reads.... As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ.

Among many other things, she has been a long-standing Sacristan and member of the choir. She also, serves as Eucharistic Minister and is a member of the finance council. Throughout her membership at St. Eugene, she has volunteered in countless capacities.

Naomi is known for her hospitality. On more than one occasion, she has opened the doors of her home to members of St. Eugene. She has invited students unable to travel home for Thanksgiving and Christmas break, to her home. She has hosted luncheons and dinners for visiting priest. She's also known to be a great cook. Some of her most requested menu items for St. Eugene events are her famous red sauce & white rice, baked chicken, and scones.

Besides her own children - Tisi, Tasha, Chete & Elorm - many people who have come to know her simply call her "Mama Naomi" which is a testament to how she cares for the people she serves in this community.

Naomi Shamatutu-Dzikunu actions in her daily life reflect that she is a woman of faith that is guided by God's words.

### LA EVANGELIZACIÓN EN LA DIÓCESIS DE PENSACOLA-TALLAHASSEE

Somos muy bendecidos por ser parte de una iglesia local tan vibrante. Aunque los católicos somos una clara minoría en el noroeste de Florida (menos del cinco por ciento de la población), ¡somos poderosos! El Espíritu Santo sembró las semillas de la fe antes de que los primeros misioneros llegaran a esta tierra. El Evangelio se arraigó y creció gracias al testimonio y al martirio de los pueblos nativos y de los inmigrantes, y continuó creciendo gracias a la perseverancia de nuestros antepasados.

Misioneros, religiosos y laicos llegaron a esta tierra procedentes del otro lado del océano, y trajeron el mensaje de salvación. Con el tiempo, la Iglesia se organizó, primero como una misión dentro de las diócesis y arquidiócesis de España, Santiago (Cuba), Nueva Orleans (LA), Mobile (AL) y San Agustín (FL). Finalmente, en 1975, se formó la Diócesis de Pensacola-Tallahassee. Desde aquí, el Evangelio continuará avanzando.

Aunque debemos difundir el Evangelio en todas partes, tenemos oportunidades únicas para evangelizar a los numerosos grupos de personas que se encuentran en nuestros límites diocesanos. En primer lugar, dado que nuestros vecinos no católicos constituyen el 95 por ciento de la población, podemos decir junto con Jesús que "¡la cosecha es abundante!" (Mt 9, 37). Un buen punto de partida es invitar a todas las personas de nuestros 18 condados a que consideren unirse a nosotros en plena comunión con la Iglesia católica. Además, muchísimas personas vienen a nuestra región a corto o largo plazo a través del ejército, o debido a vacaciones u oportunidades por temporadas. Cada año, tenemos la bendición de dar la bienvenida en nuestra comunidad a decenas de miles de estudiantes en la Universidad Estatal de Florida, la Universidad de West Florida, la Universidad de Florida A&M, y muchos otros institutos superiores locales. La pastoral universitaria ha sido y continuará siendo un medio importante de evangelización. Además, nuestros hermanos y hermanas en las numerosas prisiones y cárceles del noroeste de la Florida necesitan apoyo, oración y una conexión con el Evangelio de Jesucristo.

Esta no es una lista completa; solo pretende destacar las oportunidades específicas que tenemos en nuestra diócesis para llevar la buena nueva a nuestro prójimo

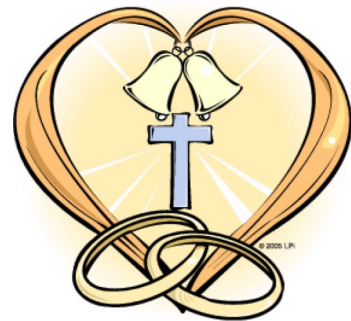


### Prayer for Married Couples
