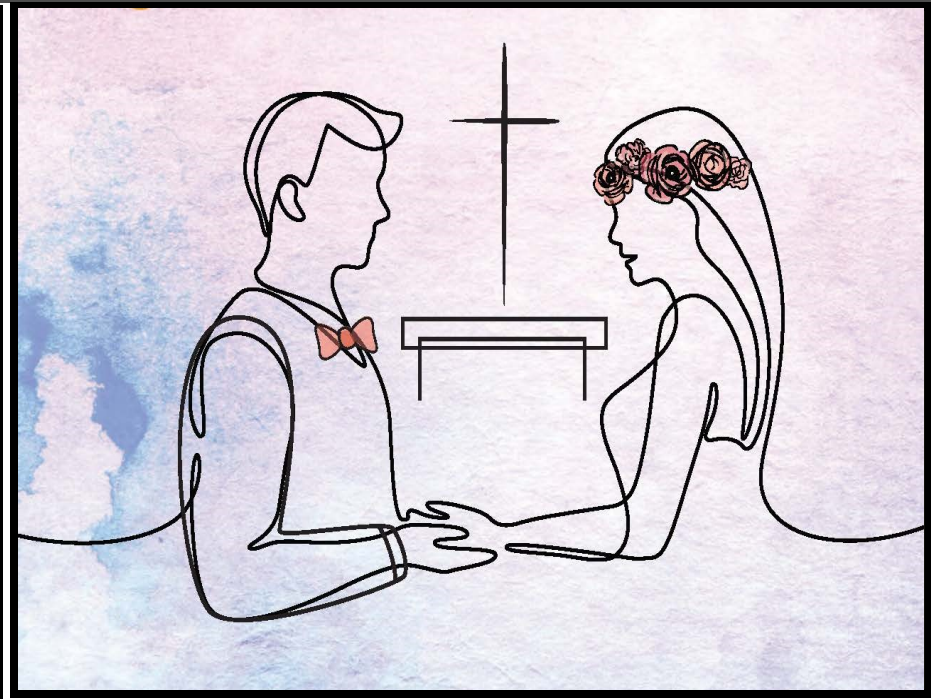

From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, February 14th, 2021 – Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Cycle B

Readings: Leviticus 13: 1-2, 44-46, **Psalm 32** “I turn to you, Lord, in time of trouble, and you fill me with the joy of salvation”, Corinthians 10: 31-11:1, Mark 1: 40-45

My dear brothers and sisters, the Gospel of today's mass present us with the healing of the leper. It must have been an extraordinary scene. He knelt before Jesus and said, “if you wish, you can make me clean”. Perhaps he had prepared a longer speech, explaining how he contracted the disease, or about how he has suffered, or about how he wish to be united with society. But in the end this simple blurted-out aspiration, filled with trust, with sincere sensitivity, was enough. “If you wish, you can make men clean”.

These few words are in a fact a powerful prayer. Jesus took pity on him, and told him, “I do will it. Be made clean.” Our Lord always wants to heal us of our weaknesses and our sins. And there is no need for us to wait months or days for him to pass through our city or our town. Every day we can find the same Jesus of Nazareth who healed the leper. He is there in the nearest tabernacle, in the heart of a soul in grace, in the sacrament of penance.

Jesus has taught us that the worst sickness is hypocrisy, the pride that leads us to conceal our sins. We have to be totally sincere with him. We have to tell the whole truth, and like the leper tell him, “Lord, if you wish, you can make me clean.”

Let us remember that our very failings, weaknesses or illnesses can be the opportunity for us to approach Christ as the leper did. And from that moment on he would have been an unconditional disciple of his Lord. Do we go to confession, pray, attend mass with these dispositions of faith and trust?

May the Lord bless us with his presence. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

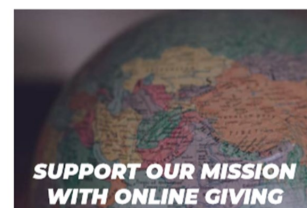

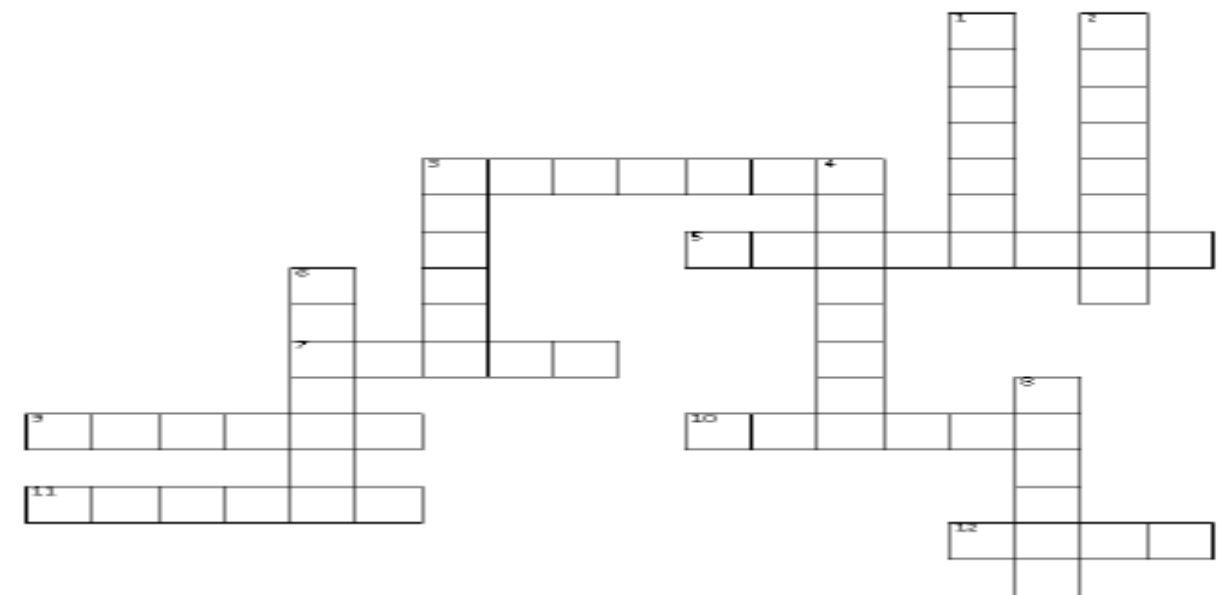

Palabras del Párroco

Domingo, 14 de febrero de 2021 - VI Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario - Cielo B

Lectura: Levíticos 13, 1-2. 44-46, Salmo 31 " Perdona, Señor, nuestras pecados", 1 Corintios 10, 31-11, 1, Marcos 1, 40-45

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, el Evangelio de la misa de hoy nos presenta la curación del leproso. Debe haber sido una escena extraordinaria. Se arrodilló ante Jesús y dijo: "Si quieres, puedes limpiarme". Quizás había preparado un discurso más largo, explicando cómo contrajo la enfermedad, o cómo ha sufrido, o cómo desea estar unido a la sociedad. Pero al final, esta simple aspiración soltada, llena de confianza, con sincera sensibilidad, fue suficiente. "Si lo desea, puede limpiar a los hombres".

Estas pocas palabras son, de hecho, una oración poderosa. Jesús se compadeció de él y le dijo: "Lo haré. Sea limpio. "Nuestro Señor siempre quiere sanarnos de nuestras debilidades y nuestros pecados. Y no es necesario que esperemos meses o días a que pase por nuestra ciudad o nuestro pueblo. Todos los días podemos encontrar al mismo Jesús de Nazaret que sanó el leproso, está en el tabernáculo más cercano, en el corazón de un alma en gracia, en el sacramento de la penitencia.

Jesús nos ha enseñado que la peor enfermedad es la hipocresía, el orgullo que nos lleva a ocultar nuestros pecados. Tenemos que ser totalmente sinceros con él. Tenemos que decir toda la verdad y, como el leproso, decirle: "Señor, si quieres, puedes limpiarme".

Recordemos que nuestras mismas fallas, debilidades o enfermedades pueden ser la oportunidad para acercarnos a Cristo como lo hizo el leproso. Y desde ese momento habría sido discípulo incondicional de su Lord de él. ¿Vamos a confesarnos, rezar, asistir a misa con estas disposiciones de fe y confianza?

Que el Señor nos bendiga con su presencia de él. En el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo. Amén
