

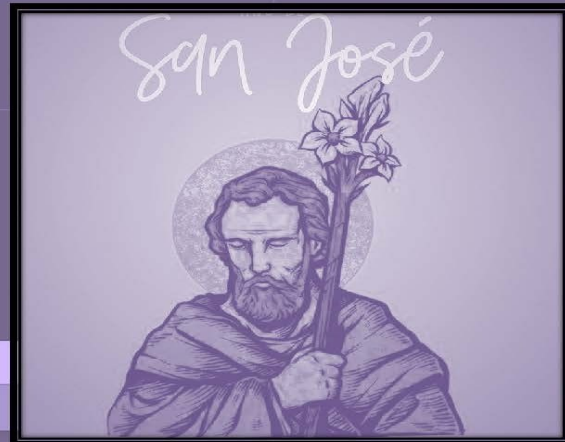

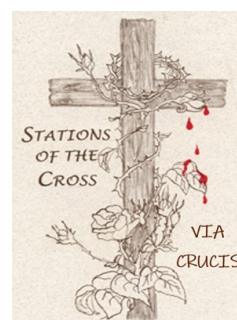

## From the Pastor's Desk...

**Sunday, February 28th, 2021 – Second Sunday of Lent - Cycle B**

**Readings:** Genesis 22: 1-2, 9a, 10-13, 15-18, **Psalm 116** “I will walk before the Lord, in the land of the living”, Romans 8: 31b-34, Mark 9: 2-10

My dear brother and sisters,

February 28th marks, this year's last day of Black History Month but the call to live in solidarity, faith, hope and joy has not ended. The first stanza of the Black National Anthem goes “Lift every voice and sing. Till earth and heaven ring. Ring with the harmonies of Liberty. Let our rejoicing rise. High as the listening skies. Let it resound as loud as the rolling sea. Sing a song full of the faith that the dark past has taught us. Sing a song full of the hope that the present has brought us. Facing the rising sun of our new day began. Let us march on till victory is won”.

Recalling our history inspires us to appreciate the present and fills us with renewed hope and zeal in building a better future. A life full of hope and love founded on the Word of God, which faith produces. Harriett Tubman said “Every great dream begins with a dreamer. Always remember, you have within you the strength, the patience, the passion to reach for the stars to change the world.” It is faith that inspires our dream.

This Sunday's first reading recounts how Abraham was tested by God. He was asked to sacrifice his son Isaac to the Lord and Abraham agreed. He took the road to Moriah and upon arrival. The Lord provided the ram for the sacrifice. The Lord we serve is not pleased with human abuse. One lesson for us this day is the faithfulness of Abraham. He believed in God totally. He had left his land and country, had given up the security of his home and the protection that came from his family and tribe. He was sure that God would keep his promise and give him numerous descendants. But why should God ask him to sacrifice Isaac? Abraham might have had some questions, but he kept his faith in love and fidelity of his Lord. Such faith is worthy of imitation by us. God has promised us love, joy, serenity, peace. But disappointments occur, difficult and painful moments and we could have the impression that God has not kept his promises. The Lord keeps his promise. We are called to trust in him as “we lift every voice and sing till earth and heaven ring. Ring with the harmonious liberty. I wish you a happy last day of the Black History Month.

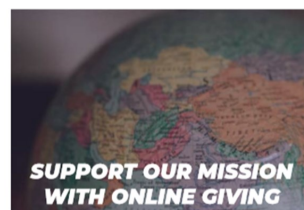

### Black History Month Speaker

Dr. Traki L. Taylor is the Chief Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Officer for the State University System of Florida. Before accepting this role, Dr. Taylor served as the Assistant Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs for the Board of Governors, SUS. In that role, she provided direction and managed the work of the academic affairs unit, including new program approval, review of existing programs, and the development and implementation of Board regulations and policies regarding academic affairs. Dr. Taylor is an experienced academic administrator. Most recently, she was the Dean of the College of Education at Florida A & M University. Between 2008 and 2016, Dr. Taylor was the Dean of the College of Education at Bowie State University in Maryland and a tenured Professor of Education. She was also a tenured associate professor at the University of Michigan-Flint, where she served in positions of increasing responsibility between 1998 and 2008, progressing from faculty to Director of Diversity Projects to Associate Chair to Associate Dean of the School of Education and Human Services. She has taught both undergraduate and graduate level courses and joyfully served as a special education teacher at an alternative middle/high school. Dr. Taylor currently serves on the Board for the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). She earned her Ph.D. and Master of Arts degrees from the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign in the Department of Educational Policy Studies, and her Bachelor of Science degree in the Department of Special Education at Coppin State College in Baltimore, Maryland.



### Rev. Justin Arockiasamy, SVD

Father Justin was born in a tiny village in India. He joined the Seminary in 1992 after 10th grade at age of 15. He made his first vows in 2000 and final vows in 2006. Father Justin was ordained a priest on May 7, 2007 and came to the United States on October 22, 2007. He assisted at St. Rose de Lima Parish, Bay St. Louis, MS from January 2008 to June 2008. He served as an Associate Pastor at Notre Dame Church, St. Martinville, LA from July 2008 to June 2011, and as Pastor at Holy Family and St. Ann Church, Lawtell, LA from July 2011 to June 2015. Father Justin was assigned as Pastor to St. Mary of the Purification Church, Houston, TX in July 2015 where he is currently ministering.

**Domingo, 28 de febrero de 2021 - II Domingo de Cuaresma - Ciclo B**  
**Lectura:** Génesis 22, 1-2. 9-13. 15-18, Salmo 115 “Siempre confiaré en el Señor.”, Romanos 8, 31b-34, Marcos 9, 2-10

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas, El 28 de febrero es el último día del Mes de la Historia Afroamericana de este año, pero el llamado a vivir en solidaridad, fe, esperanza y alegría no ha terminado. La primera estrofa del Himno Afroamericano Nacional dice “Levanta cada voz y canta. Hasta que resuenen la tierra y el cielo. Suena con las armonías de Libertad. Que nuestro regocijo se eleve. Alto como los cielos que escuchan. Que resuene tan fuerte como el mar ondulante. Canta una canción llena de la fe que nos ha enseñado el oscuro pasado. Canta una canción llena de la esperanza que nos ha traído el presente. De cara al sol naciente de nuestro nuevo día comenzó. Marchemos hasta la victoria”. Recordar nuestra historia nos inspira a apreciar el presente y nos llena de renovada esperanza y celo por construir un futuro mejor. Una vida llena de esperanza y amor fundada en la Palabra de Dios, que produce la fe. Harriett Tubman dijo: “Todo gran sueño comienza con un soñador. Recuerda siempre, tienes dentro de ti la fuerza, la paciencia, la pasión para alcanzar las estrellas para cambiar el mundo”. Es la fe lo que inspira nuestro sueño. La primera lectura de este domingo relata cómo Dios puso a prueba a Abraham. Se le pidió que sacrificara a su hijo Isaac al Señor y Abraham estuvo de acuerdo. Tomó el camino hacia Moriah y al llegar. El Señor proporcionó el carnero para el sacrificio. Al Señor al que servimos no le agradan los abusos humanos. Una lección para nosotros este día es la fidelidad de Abraham. Creía en Dios totalmente. Abraham pudo haber tenido algunas preguntas, pero mantuvo su fe en el amor y la fidelidad de su Señor. Tal fe es digna de ser imitada por nosotros. Dios nos ha prometido amor, alegría, serenidad, paz. Pero ocurren decepciones, momentos difíciles y dolorosos y podríamos tener la impresión de que Dios no ha cumplido sus promesas. El Señor cumple su promesa. Estamos llamados a confiar en él mientras “alzamos toda voz y cantamos hasta que resuenen la tierra y el cielo”. Suena con la libertad armoniosa. Les deseo un feliz último día del Mes de la Historia Afroamericana.

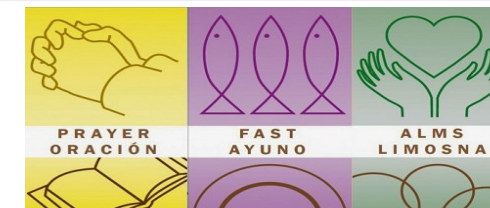
