My dear brothers and sisters, when we reflect on the terrible problems some people have, we ask ourselves why it should be like this. In the first reading Job describes in dramatic terms the situation of humanity on earth. The gospel reading is a reply to the problems by Job. Jesus sees the sad reality of suffering and disease. He takes it on and exhorts his disciples to engage in bringing about the new world that he has just begun. In the second reading we have the example of Paul, a man who did not spare himself in his dedication to his mission, giving up his rights so as not to be an obstacle to the growth of the kingdom.

We are in the Black history month and as we reflect on the experiences of many people. There has always been a crossroad between the Christian faith and grave moral issues like war, capital punishment, abortion, racial prejudice, poverty and care for the earth. We are reminded to examine each event and news through the eyes of our catholic faith. As Catholics we are reminded never to give up on prayer.

This Sunday, we begin the “Catholic Sharing Appeal” (CSA). The central theme is prayer and gratitude. Even though we have been in a challenging time, you contributed immensely in various activities of the church and we are very grateful. It is our prayer that the Lord bless us with a successful campaign and may the Lord through his gracious will bless you and your good intentions. Amen

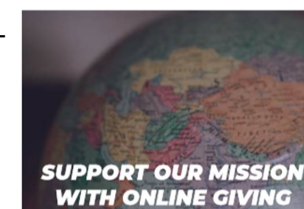

**Domingo, 7 de febrero de 2021 - V Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario - Ciclo B**

**Lectura:** Job 7, 1-4.6-7, Salmo 146 “Alabemos al Señor, nuestro Dios.”, 1 Corintios 9, 16-19. 22-23, Mateo 1, 29-39

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas, cuando reflexionamos sobre los terribles problemas que tienen algunas personas, nos preguntamos por qué debería ser así. En la primera lectura, Job describe en términos dramáticos la situación de la humanidad en la tierra. La lectura del evangelio es una respuesta a los problemas de Job. Jesús ve la triste realidad del sufrimiento y la enfermedad. Lo acepta y exhorta a sus discípulos a participar en la realización del nuevo mundo que acaba de comenzar. En la segunda lectura tenemos el ejemplo de Pablo, un hombre que no escatimó en su dedicación a su misión, renunciando a sus derechos para no ser un obstáculo para el crecimiento del reino.

Estamos en el mes de la historia afroamericana y mientras reflexionamos sobre las experiencias de muchas personas. Siempre ha habido una encrucijada entre la fe cristiana y graves problemas morales como la guerra, la pena capital, el aborto, los prejuicios raciales, la pobreza y el cuidado de la tierra. Se nos recuerda que examinemos cada evento y noticia a través de los ojos de nuestra fe católica. Como católicos, se nos recuerda que nunca debemos dejar de orar.

Este domingo, comenzamos la “Campaña para compartir católicos” (CSA). El tema central es la oración y la gratitud. A pesar de que hemos pasado por un momento desafiante, usted contribuyó inmensamente en varias actividades de la iglesia y estamos muy agradecidos. 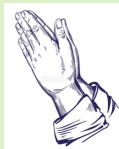

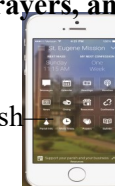
