## From the Pastor's Desk...

### Sunday, January 10th, 2021 – The Baptism of the Lord - Cycle B

**Readings:** Isaiah 42: 1-4, 6-7, Ps: 29 “The Lord will bless his people with peace”, Acts 10: 34-38, Mark 1: 7-11

Today we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ in the waters of the Jordan by John the Baptist, which also serves as the first Sunday in ordinary time. The presence of Jesus made a difference because his presence makes the Baptism of John to do what John said it could not do. At his baptism the whole cosmos is impacted by his act of humility. The heavens are not gently opened but torn asunder- a sign that the barrier between God and man is being removed. God the Father puts his stamp of approval on Jesus' mission and delights in his obedient acceptance of it. His words of affirmation, you are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.

For thirty years he had stayed in Nazareth. Faithfully he had discharged his duties to his home. For long he must have been conscious that the time for him to go out will come. He must have waited for a sign. The emergence of John was that sign. Jesus knew when John emerged that the moment of decision had come. He made the decision to be baptized not because he himself is a sinner but because of his total solidarity with sinful humanity, a solidarity that will lead him to the cross. In life, there comes moments of decision which may be accepted or postponed or rejected.

Probably, the decision we need to make today is to cooperate with the spirit of God for the manifestation of the gifts he bestowed upon us at our baptism. Let us all pray for the sending of the Spirit, particularly when we face change and important decisions. “You are my beloved Son, with you I am well pleased”. May we trust in this words that the Lord tells us and take decisions inspired by it. I wish you a blessed week. In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

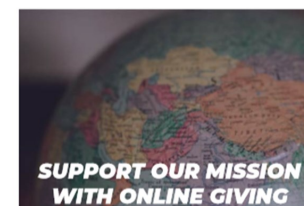

**Domingo, 10 de enero de 2021 - El Bautismo del Señor - Ciclo B**

**Lectura:** Isaías 42, 1-4. 6-7, Salmo 28 "Te alabamos, Señor", Hechos 10, 34-38, Marcos 1, 7-11

Hoy celebramos el Bautismo de nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo en las aguas del Jordán por Juan el Bautista, que también sirve como primer domingo del tiempo ordinario. La presencia de Jesús marcó la diferencia porque su presencia hace que el Bautismo de Juan haga lo que Juan dijo que no podía hacer. En su bautismo, todo el cosmos se ve impactado por su acto de humildad. Los cielos no se abren suavemente, sino que se rompen en dos, una señal de que la barrera entre Dios y el hombre está desapareciendo. Dios Padre pone su sello de aprobación a la misión de Jesús y se deleita en su obediente aceptación de ella. Sus palabras de afirmación, eres mi Hijo amado; contigo estoy muy complacido.

En la vida llegan momentos de decisión que pueden aceptarse, posponerse o rechazarse.

Probablemente, la decisión que debemos tomar hoy es cooperar con el espíritu de Dios para la manifestación de los dones que nos otorgó en nuestro bautismo. Oremos todos por el envío del Espíritu, particularmente cuando enfrentamos cambios y decisiones importantes. "Tú eres mi Hijo amado, contigo me complazco". Confiemos en estas palabras que el Señor nos dice y tomemos decisiones inspiradas en ellas. Les deseo una feliz semana. En el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.
