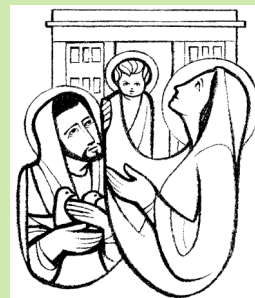

## From the Pastor's Desk...

**Sunday, January 24th, 2021 – Third Sunday in Ordinary Time - Cycle B**

**Readings:** Jonah 3: 1-5, 10, Psalm 25 “Teach me your ways, O Lord”, 1 Corinthians 7:29-31, Mark 1:14-20

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, one of the most famous stories in the Bible is the tale of Jonah, the runaway prophet. Jonah is commanded by God to go to the great city of Nineveh and tell the people that God is going to destroy them in forty days. If this is his first mission, it is also his first refusal. But he goes through the experience of being swallowed by a whale in order to be born again (repentance).

Jonah has the opportunity of repentance. He prays, he reflects, he remembers; and then he promises to fulfill the word of God. The word of God is addressed to him a second time: “Up! Go to Nineveh, the great city, and preach to them as I told you to.” This time Jonah obeys. He goes into the city and tells the people that all of them will be destroyed in forty days. Surprisingly, everyone pays attention. The king and his ministers command the people to renounce their evil behavior: “who knows, God may yet repent and turn from his furious anger?” They hope that if they repent, so too will God.

Go repents when the people repent. Everyone is overjoyed. All except Jonah. He argued with God. *“That is why I fled...I knew that you were a God of tenderness and compassion, slow to anger, rich in graciousness and mercy, relenting from evil.”*

My dear friends, Jonah was obsessed with being right and he was willing to see all the people perish to be proved right. But the prophet had to learn that the point of his prophecy was not accuracy but repentance. True, Jonah has been made to look foolish; but his foolishness is much less important than people's repentance. He learnt that it is never too late to repent. The story of Jonah holds out hope for all of us. In the story everyone repents: Jonah himself, the people of Nineveh and even God. Repentance is good news because it means the nothing is settled, nothing is sealed. If God can begin again, we can begin again and again and again.

May the blessings of the Lord Jesus Christ be with you.

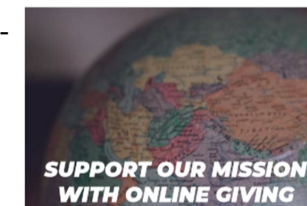

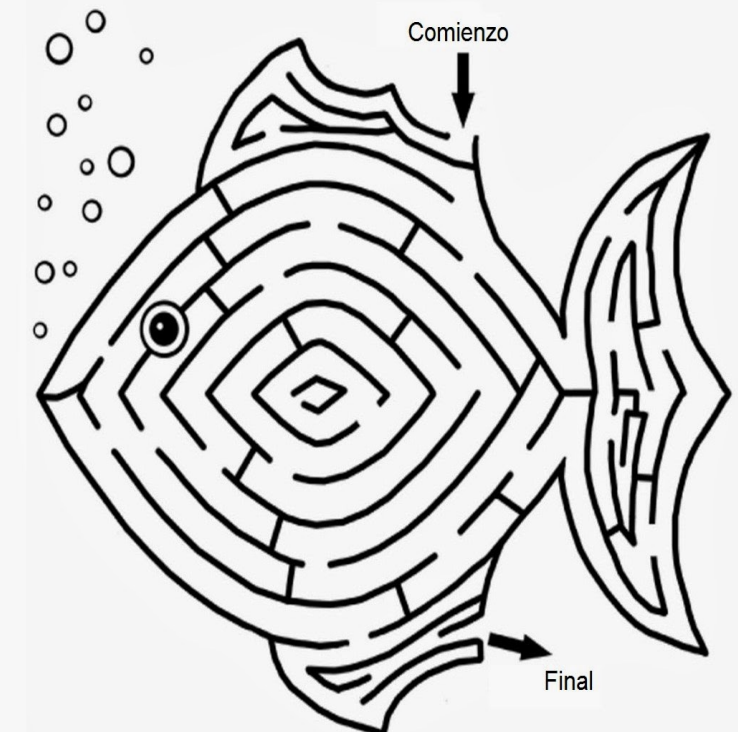

## Palabras del Párroco

Domingo, 24 de enero de 2021 - III Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario - Ciclo B

Lectura: Jonas 3, 1-5. 10, Salmo 24 "Descúbrenos, Señor, tus caminos.", 1 Corintios 7, 29-31, Marcos 1, 14-20

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, una de las historias más famosas de la Biblia es la historia de Jonás, el profeta fugitivo. Dios le ordena a Jonás que vaya a la gran ciudad de Nínive y le diga al pueblo que Dios los destruirá en cuarenta días. Si esta es su primera misión, también es su primer rechazo. Pero pasa por la experiencia de ser tragado por una ballena para nacer de nuevo (arrepentimiento).

Jonás tiene la oportunidad de arrepentirse. Reza, reflexiona, recuerda; y luego promete cumplir la palabra de Dios. La palabra de Dios se le dirige por segunda vez: "¡Arriba! Ve a Nínive, la gran ciudad, y predicales como te dije ". Esta vez, Jonás obedece. Entra en la ciudad y le dice a la gente que todos serán destruidos en cuarenta días. Sorprendentemente, todos prestan atención. El rey y sus ministros ordenan al pueblo que renuncie a su mala conducta: "¿quién sabe, Dios aún puede arrepentirse y volverse de su furiosa ira?" Esperan que si se arrepienten, Dios también lo hará.

Ve y arrepientete cuando la gente se arrepiente. Todo el mundo está encantado. Todos excepto Jonás.

Discutió con Dios. "Por eso huí ... sabía que eras un Dios de ternura y compasión, lento para la ira, rico en gracia y misericordia, arrepintiéndote del mal".

Mis queridos amigos, Jonah estaba obsesionado con tener razón y estaba dispuesto a ver morir a toda la gente para que se demostrara que tenía razón. Pero el profeta tuvo que aprender que el objetivo de su profecía no era la precisión sino el arrepentimiento. Es cierto que a Jonás se le ha hecho parecer tonto; pero su necesidad es mucho menos importante que el arrepentimiento de la gente. Aprendió que nunca es demasiado tarde para arrepentirse. La historia de Jonás es una esperanza para todos. En la historia todos se arrepienten: el mismo Jonás, la gente de Nínive e incluso Dios. El arrepentimiento es una buena noticia porque significa que nada está resuelto, nada está sellado. Si Dios puede empezar de nuevo, podemos empezar una y otra y otra vez. Que las bendiciones del Señor Jesucristo te acompañen.

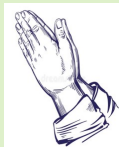

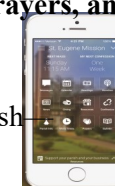
