From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, July 11th, 2021 – Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Cycle B

Readings: Exodus 1:8-14, 22, Psalm 124 “Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation”, Matthew 10:34—11:1

“God chose us in Christ before the foundation of the world.” (Ephesians 1:4)

Dear brothers and sisters,

This Sunday readings invite us to reflect on our being God’s children and of our call to preach and practice the Good News of Jesus by bearing witness to God’s love. The first reading (Am 7:12-15), tells us that our witnessing mission will be rejected, as happened to the Old Testament prophets like Amos. God’s chose him to from a shepherd and tree-dresser to a prophet. Like Amos, we are chosen by God, through the mystery of Divine adoption in Jesus, to become missionaries and to preach the “Good News,” mainly by Christian witnessing. In the second reading (Eph 1:3-14), St. Paul explains the blessings that we have received through our Baptism and our responsibility take the good news to others. Then Paul reveals the Divine secret that it is God’s eternal plan to extend salvation, through Jesus, to all mankind, first to the Jews and then to the Gentiles. Hence, the Jewish and the Gentile Christians need to love, help, and respect one another, and thus, to proclaim Jesus, giving true witness by their lives.

In today’s Gospel (Mk 6:1-13), Jesus instructs the twelve apostles to preach the “Good News” of repentance, forgiveness of sins, liberation, and to bring healing to the sick, and salvation through Jesus name. They are to preach repentance, a change of heart and a change of action taking people from a self-centered life to a God-centered life. We, too, have a witnessing mission: We are called to be witnessing disciples in our daily living. As witnessing disciples, we need to follow, imitate, reflect, and radiate only Jesus. As apostles, we need to evangelize the world by sharing with others our experience of God and His Son, Jesus. Our Christian life must reflect Jesus words, radiating the love, mercy, forgiveness, spirit of humble service and concern of Jesus to the people around us. We also have the liberating mission of helping to free people from the demons of alcohol, drugs, hatred, jealousy, racial prejudice, etc.

Palabras del Párroco

Domingo, 11 de julio de 2021 - XV Domingo Ordinario - Ciclo B

Lectura: Exodo 1,8-14, 22, Salmo 123 "Muéstranos, Señor, tu misericordia", Mateo 10,34—11,1

"Dios nos escogió en Cristo antes de la fundación del mundo" (Efesios 1: 4)

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, Las lecturas de este domingo nos invitan a reflexionar sobre nuestro ser hijos de Dios y sobre nuestro llamado a predicar y practicar la Buena Nueva de Jesús dando testimonio del amor de Dios por él. La primera lectura (Am 7: 12-15) nos dice que nuestra misión de testificar será rechazada, como sucedió con los profetas del Antiguo Testamento como Amós. Dios lo eligió de pastor y arboricultor a profeta. Como Amós, somos elegidos por Dios, a través del misterio de la adopción divina en Jesús, para convertirnos en misioneros y predicar la "Buena Nueva", principalmente mediante el testimonio cristiano. En la segunda lectura (Efesios 1: 3-14), San Pablo explica las bendiciones que hemos recibido a través de nuestro Bautismo y nuestra responsabilidad de llevar las buenas nuevas a los demás. Luego, Pablo revela el secreto divino de que el plan eterno de Dios es extender la salvación, a través de Jesús, a toda la humanidad, primero a los judíos y luego a los gentiles. Por lo tanto, los cristianos judíos y gentiles necesitan amarse, ayudarse y respetarse mutuamente, y así, proclamar a Jesús, dando verdadero testimonio con sus vidas.

En el Evangelio de hoy (Mc 6: 1-13), Jesús instruye a los doce apóstoles a predicar las "Buenas Nuevas" del arrepentimiento, el perdón de los pecados, la liberación y traer la curación a los enfermos y la salvación a través del nombre de Jesús. Deben predicar el arrepentimiento, un cambio de corazón y un cambio de acción, llevando a las personas de una vida egocéntrica a una vida centrada en Dios. Nosotros también tenemos una misión de testificar: estamos llamados a ser discípulos testigos en nuestra vida diaria. Como discípulos testigos, necesitamos seguir, imitar, reflexionar e irradiar solo a Jesús. Como apóstoles, necesitamos evangelizar el mundo compartiendo con otros nuestra experiencia de Dios y de Su Hijo de él, Jesús. Nuestra vida cristiana debe reflejar las palabras de Jesús, irradiando el amor, la misericordia, el perdón, el espíritu de servicio humilde y la preocupación de Jesús por las personas que nos rodean. También tenemos la misión liberadora de ayudar a liberar a las personas de los demonios del alcohol, las drogas, el odio, los celos, los prejuicios raciales, etc.

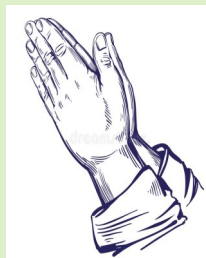
