**The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ – Sunday, June 6th, 2021

From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, June 6th, 2021 – The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ - Cycle B
Readings: Exodus 24:3-8, Psalm 116 “I will take the cup of salvation, and call on the name of the Lord.” Hebrews 9:11-15, Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, this Sunday we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) and we are so blessed that eighteen members of our parish will be confirmed by Bishop Bill Wack. The Eucharist is thanksgiving and we are indeed filled with gratitude to the Lord and all the people who helped in preparing our brothers and sister.

Jesus Christ gave the Sacrament of his Most Holy Body and Blood to the Church so that you and I can enter into communion with him and one another and so be his sacrament to the world. You are the body of Christ, I am the body of Christ, and the church is the body of Christ. We are the one body of Christ.

The Eucharist is meant to be the food for the community. The bread is broken among brothers and sisters. Jesus says in the gospel that ‘the blood of the new covenant has been shed for many. Therefore we have the responsibility to accept others into the community. God does not make distinctions between worthy and unworthy. In the Eucharist all of us are equal and all of us are invited to enter into communion with Christ.

The Eucharist is not something we come to watch; rather, it is something we come to do. We gather as a consecrated people to do something together. In the action of the Mass we hold holy the memory of Jesus, we share the bread that is broken, we accept the cup that is held out to us. Week by week throughout the year, we strengthen each other by our sharing and our faith, so that all our time is consecrated to the Lord.

Through the Holy Eucharist, Jesus is made real to us community of believers and all those who eat his body and drink his blood become part of him and make up a new people, the beginning of a new humanity whose only law is to serve others. The reception of the Holy Eucharist invites us to make our lives identical to Christ's and a promise of total dedication to the service of others. This is why St Paul recommends us to examine our hearts well before receiving the Eucharist (1 Corinthians 11:28-29).

Congratulations to those who are been confirmed! Happy feast day!

Domingo, 6 de junio de 2021 - Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo - Ciclo B

Lectura: Exodo 24, 3-8, Salmo 115 "Levantaré el cáliz de la salvación", Hebreos 9, 11-15, Marcos 14, 12-16. 22-26

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, este domingo celebramos la solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo (Corpus Christi) y somos tan bendecidos que dieciocho miembros de nuestra parroquia serán confirmados por el Obispo Bill Wack. La Eucaristía es acción de gracias y de hecho estamos llenos de gratitud hacia el Señor y todas las personas que ayudaron en la preparación de nuestros hermanos y hermanas.

Jesucristo dio el Sacramento de su Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre a la Iglesia para que tú y yo podamos entrar en comunión con él y entre nosotros y así ser su sacramento para el mundo. Tú eres el cuerpo de Cristo, yo soy el cuerpo de Cristo y la iglesia es el cuerpo de Cristo. Somos el único cuerpo de Cristo. La Eucaristía está destinada a ser el alimento de la comunidad. Semana tras semana durante todo el año, nos fortalecemos mutuamente con nuestro compartir y nuestra fe, para que todo nuestro tiempo esté consagrado al Señor.
