**From the Pastor's Desk...**

**Sunday, March 13, 2022 – Second Sunday of Lent - Cycle C**

**Readings:** Genesis 15:5-12, 17-18, Psalm 27 “The Lord is my light and my salvation”, Phillipians 3:17—4:1, Luke 9: 28b-36

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, retreat is very important in our Christian life. It can be defined as a definite time spent away from one's normal life for the purpose of reconnecting, usually in prayer, with God. The gospel starts by recounting the transfiguration. In which Jesus took Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray. It shows us one of the important moments in the life of Jesus, when he came to understand his mission, and he realizes he will carry it out through humiliation and defeat. Jesus wants his disciples to accept the plan of the Father for him but they do not do so. Only after his death will they understand how the way of the cross was the way to life.

The second reading continues with this gospel idea and invites all of us to die with Christ. The death we speak of here is the destruction of our selfishness.

The first reading completes the message of the liturgy of today by presenting Abraham to us, the man who placed his trust in God and, because of this, was promised a country and numerous descendants. Christians who have the courage to place their trust in God, though in human eyes may appear to be failures, will in reality have numerous descendants. A retreat refreshes and revitalizes, gives the opportunity for more time spent in prayer and contemplation, and rekindles and deepens one's relationship with God. It creates the opportunity for a person to more clearly hear God's call and to seek God's healing grace and thereby attain a degree of spiritual renewal. It is an invitation to temporarily leave behind the usual distractions we all face for a time long enough to allow relaxation and for an inner change to occur: the ongoing conversion of heart that is critical to deepen faith.

Lent is a time that the Lord invites us “come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while with me”. As a church we have the Spanish lenten retreat on Saturday March 19 and the English Lenten revival March 21 to 23rd. I wish to encourage all parishioners to respond to this call as we journey together as a community of faith.

May the Lord bless us.

## Palabras del Párroco

**Domingo, 13 de marzo de 2022 - Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma - Ciclo C**  
**Lecturas:** Genesis 15, 5-12. 17-18, Salmo 26 “El Señor es mi luz y mi salvación”, Filipenses 3, 17-4, 1, Lucas 9, 28b-36

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, el retiro es muy importante en nuestra vida cristiana. Se puede definir como un tiempo definido que se pasa fuera de la vida normal de uno con el propósito de reconectarse, generalmente en oración, con Dios. El evangelio comienza relatando la transfiguración. En el que Jesús tomó a Pedro, Juan y Santiago y subió al monte a orar. Nos muestra uno de los momentos importantes en la vida de Jesús, cuando llega a comprender su misión, y se da cuenta de que la llevará a cabo a través de la humillación y la derrota. Jesús quiere que sus discípulos acepten el plan del Padre para él pero no lo hacen. Solo después de su muerte comprenderán cómo el camino de la cruz fue el camino a la vida.

La segunda lectura continúa con esta idea evangélica e invita a todos a morir con Cristo. La muerte de la que hablamos aquí es la destrucción de nuestro egoísmo.

La primera lectura completa el mensaje de la liturgia de hoy presentándonos a Abraham, el hombre que puso su confianza en Dios y, por eso, se le prometió una patria y una descendencia numerosa. Los cristianos que tienen la valentía de poner su confianza en Dios, aunque a los ojos humanos puedan parecer fracasados, en realidad tendrán una descendencia numerosa. Un retiro refresca y revitaliza, brinda la oportunidad de dedicar más tiempo a la oración y la contemplación, y reaviva y profundiza la relación con Dios. Crea la oportunidad para que una persona escuche más claramente el llamado de Dios y busque la gracia sanadora de Dios y, por lo tanto, alcance un grado de renovación espiritual. Es una invitación a dejar atrás temporalmente las distracciones habituales que todos enfrentamos por un tiempo lo suficientemente largo como para permitir la relajación y que ocurra un cambio interior: la conversión continua del corazón que es fundamental para profundizar la fe.

La Cuaresma es un tiempo en el que el Señor nos invita a “salir solos a un lugar desierto y descansar un poco conmigo”. Como iglesia tenemos el retiro de cuaresma en español el sábado 19 de marzo y el avivamiento de cuaresma en inglés del 21 al 23 de marzo. Deseo alentar a todos los feligreses a responder a este llamado mientras caminamos juntos como una comunidad de fe.
