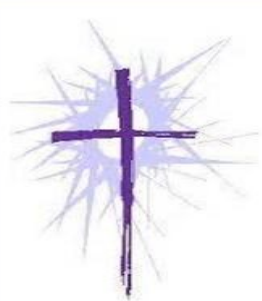

**From the Pastor's Desk...**

**Sunday, March 27, 2022 – Fourth Sunday of Lent - Cycle C**

**Readings:** Joshua 5:9a, 10-12, Psalm “Taste and see the goodness of the Lord”, 2 Corinthians 5:17-21, Luke 15:1-3, 11-32

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, this Sunday gospel presents us the parable of the Prodigal Son. It is a classic Lenten text as it sums up many of the main points of this graceful season. It is about a ‘turning around’, a homecoming. Reconciliation is the main focus as is relationship: it is a healing of the rift that was caused by the son’s selfishness. The Father’s gift of love to his son is extraordinary in the circumstances; it is without any conditions or ‘punishment’ that we would normally expect. God will go to any length to bring the person back to a loving relationship with himself.

Though it is often called the ‘Prodigal Son’, it is rather the story of the Prodigal Father, who is outstanding in his generosity and compassion. It is the father who is the central figure in this story. Initially he seems unwise in giving his wealth to his younger son. We can easily relate to the behavior of the son who recklessly spends all on pleasure and self-indulgence. Through it all, the father merely waits and watches. Extraordinarily, he is never angry and never condemns. When the son finally ‘comes to his senses’, and humbly makes his way home, he is overwhelmed by his father’s love and affection. Nothing is too good to be brought out to celebrate the return of the boy who “was dead and has come to life again”.

This is a picture of love and forgiveness that is not normally the way things work out. Normally when someone squanders all the family wealth in such a reckless way, the welcome is far from warm and there is a sense in which the person ‘deserves’ to be punished for such behavior. More than likely most of us would react like the elder son (the end of the story not quoted here). He was obedient, dutifully serving his father and, understandably, he feels strong resentment at the ‘soft’ treatment doled out to his brother - how dare the father act like this? It is simply not fair!

Lent reminds us of the unconditional nature of God’s love for us. Like the younger son, we don’t really deserve it. It is hard to believe and accept. No matter what kind of person I may be, no matter what I have done against God, against others, or against myself; God’s extraordinary love (called agape in Greek) for me is absolutely guaranteed. This is the essence of the Christian message and the basis of our hope and transformation. Love heals and reconciles, it forgives the past and opens up a new future. It is an opportunity for a new start and a new freedom. Remember, it is never too late for God who always invites, hopes, renews.

May the Lord bless us, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

## Palabras del Párroco

**Domingo, 27 de marzo de 2022 - Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma - Ciclo C**

**Lecturas:** Josué 5, 9a. 10-12, Salmo 33, "Haz la prueba y verás qué bueno es el Señor", 2 Corintios 5, 17-21, Lucas 15, 1-3. 11-32

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, este evangelio dominical nos presenta la parábola del hijo pródigo. Es un texto clásico de Cuaresma ya que resume muchos de los puntos principales de esta elegante temporada. Se trata de un 'dar la vuelta', de un regreso a casa. La reconciliación es el enfoque principal como lo es la relación: es una curación de la ruptura que fue causada por el egoísmo del hijo. El don de amor del Padre a su hijo es extraordinario en las circunstancias; es sin ninguna condición o 'castigo' que normalmente esperaríamos. Dios hará todo lo posible para que la persona vuelva a tener una relación amorosa consigo mismo.

Aunque a menudo se le llama el 'Hijo Pródigo', es más bien la historia del Padre Pródigo, quien se destaca por su generosidad y compasión hacia él. Es el padre quien es la figura central en esta historia. Inicialmente, parece imprudente al dar su riqueza a su hijo menor. Podemos relacionarnos fácilmente con el comportamiento del hijo que gasta todo imprudentemente en placer y autocomplacencia. A través de todo, el padre simplemente espera y observa. Extraordinariamente, nunca se enoja y nunca condena. Cuando el hijo finalmente "recupera el sentido" y humildemente se dirige a casa, se siente abrumado por el amor y el afecto de su padre hacia él. Nada es demasiado bueno para ser sacado a relucir para celebrar el regreso del niño que "estaba muerto y ha vuelto a la vida".

Esta es una imagen de amor y perdón que normalmente no es la forma en que funcionan las cosas. Normalmente, cuando alguien despilfarrar todo el patrimonio familiar de una manera tan imprudente, la acogida dista mucho de ser cálida y en cierto sentido la persona 'merece' ser castigada por tal comportamiento. Lo más probable es que la mayoría de nosotros reaccionaríamos como el hijo mayor (el final de la historia no se cita aquí). Estaba sirviendo obedientemente a su padre y, comprensiblemente, siente un fuerte resentimiento por el trato 'suave' que le dio a su hermano. ¿Cómo se atreve el padre a actuar así? ¡Simplemente no es justo!

La Cuaresma nos recuerda la naturaleza incondicional del amor de Dios por nosotros. Al igual que el hijo menor, en realidad no lo merecemos. Es difícil de creer y aceptar. No importa qué tipo de persona pueda ser, no importa lo que haya hecho contra Dios, contra los demás o contra mí mismo; El extraordinario amor de Dios (llamado ágape en griego) por mí está absolutamente garantizado. Esta es la esencia del mensaje cristiano y la base de nuestra esperanza y transformación. El amor cura y reconcilia, perdona el pasado y abre un nuevo futuro. Es una oportunidad para un nuevo comienzo y una nueva libertad. Recuerda, nunca es tarde para Dios que siempre invita, espera, renueva.

Que el Señor nos bendiga, en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.
