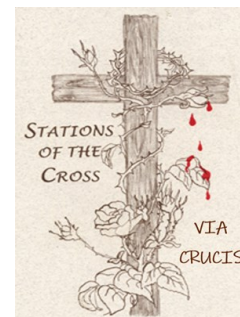

## From the Pastor's Desk...

**Sunday, March 7th, 2021 – Third Sunday of Lent - Cycle B**

**Readings:** Exodus 20: 1-17, Psalm 19 “Lord, you have the words of everlasting life”, 1Corintios 1: 22-25, John 2: 13-35

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, we just had our parish Lenten retreat with the theme “The year of St Joseph: an invitation to the desert.” I believe that those who were able to participate found it uplifting and very resourceful as I did. I wish to express our sincere gratitude to our retreat directors: Fr Justin Arockiasamy, SVD (English retreat), and Mr. Jose de Jesus Garcia Padilla and Mrs. Norma Velez de Garcia (Spanish retreat). On March 19, the church celebrates the feast of St Joseph.

Pope Francis with his apostolic letter “Patris corde” (With a Father’s Heart), recalls the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the declaration of St Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. To mark that, he proclaimed a “Year of St Joseph” from December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021.

The Holy father wrote “Patris corde” against the backdrop of Covid-19 pandemic, which, he says, has helped us see more clearly the importance of “ordinary” people who, though far from the limelight, exercise patience and offer hope every day. In this, they resemble Saint Joseph, ‘the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence,’ who nonetheless played “an incomparable role in the history of salvation.”

He describes St Joseph as a beloved, tender, obedient father. He welcomed the will of God by accepting Mary unconditionally. He is a creatively courageous father, example of love: he was able to turn problem into a possibility by trusting in divine providence. St Joseph is a father who teaches the value, dignity and joy of work. He is a father “in the shadows”, centered on Mary and Jesus.

In his letter, Pope Francis notes how, “Every day, for over forty years, following Lauds [Morning Prayer]” he has “recited a prayer to Saint Joseph taken from a nineteenth-century French prayer book of the Congregation of the Sisters of Jesus and Mary.” This prayer, he says, expresses devotion and trust, and even poses a certain challenge to Saint Joseph,” on account of its closing words: “My beloved father, all my trust is in you. Let it not be said that I invoked you in vain, and since you can do everything with Jesus and Mary, show me that your goodness is as great as your power.” St Joseph, intercede for us. In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

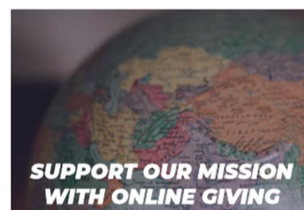

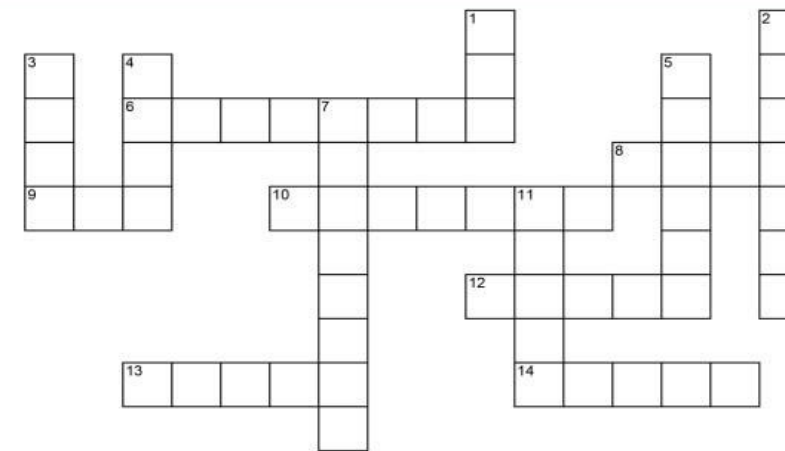

On March 1, 2021 Governor DeSantis signed [Executive Order 21-47](#) expanding eligibility requirements for the COVID-19 vaccine across the state of Florida. Effective March 3, 2021, eligible individuals include:

- Long-term care facility residents and staff
- Persons 65 years of age and older
- Health care personnel with direct patient contact
- K-12 school employees 50 years of age and older
- Firefighters 50 years of age and older

● In addition to hospital providers, physicians, advanced practice registered nurses, and pharmacists may vaccinate persons determined by a physician to be extremely vulnerable to COVID-19.

**Palabras del Párroco**

**Domingo, 7 de marzo de 2021 - III Domingo de Cuaresma - Ciclo B**

**Lectura:** Exodo 20, 1-17, Salmo 18 "Tú tienes, Señor, palabras de vida eternal", 1 Corintios 1, 22-25, Juan 2, 13-25

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, acabamos de celebrar nuestro retiro de Cuaresma parroquial con el tema "El año de San José: una invitación al desierto". Creo que aquellos que pudieron participar lo encontraron edificante y muy ingenioso como yo. Deseo expresar nuestro más sincero agradecimiento a los directores de nuestro retiro: el P. Justin Arockiasamy, SVD (retiro en inglés), y el Sr. José de Jesús García Padilla y la Sra. Norma Vélez de García (retiro en español). El 19 de marzo, la iglesia celebra la fiesta de San José.

El Papa Francisco con su carta apostólica Patris corde recuerda el 150 aniversario de la declaración de San José como Patrón de la Iglesia Universal. Para marcar eso, he proclamado un "Año de San José" del 8 de diciembre de 2020 al 8 de diciembre de 2021.

El Santo Padre escribió "Patris corde" en el contexto de la pandemia Covid-19, que, dice, nos ha ayudado a ver más claramente la importancia de las personas "comunes" que, aunque lejos del centro de atención, ejercen la paciencia y ofrecen esperanza todos los días. En esto se asemejan a san José, "el hombre que pasa desapercibido, presencia cotidiana, discreta y escondida", que sin embargo tuvo "un papel incomparable en la historia de la salvación".

Describe a San José como un padre amado, tierno y obediente. Acogió la voluntad de Dios al aceptar a María incondicionalmente. Es un padre creativamente valiente, ejemplo de amor: supo convertir el problema en una posibilidad confiando en la providencia divina. San José es un padre que enseña el valor, la dignidad y la alegría del trabajo. Es un padre "en las sombras", centrado en María y Jesús.

En su carta, el Papa Francisco señala cómo, "todos los días, durante más de cuarenta años, siguiendo las Laudes [oración de la mañana]", ha "recitado una oración a San José tomada de un libro de oraciones francés del siglo XIX de la Congregación de las Hermanas de Jesús y María. "Esta oración, dice, expresa devoción y confianza, e incluso plantea un cierto desafío a San José", por sus palabras finales: "Mi amado padre, toda mi confianza está en ti. No se diga que invoqué tú en vano, y como puedes hacer todo con Jesús y María, muéstrame que tu bondad es tan grande como tu poder. San José, intercede por nosotros. En el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.
