**From the Pastor's Desk...**

**Sunday, November 14th, 2021 – XXXIII Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Readings:** Daniel 12:1-3, Psalm 16 “You are my inheritance, O Lord!”, Hebrews 10:11-14, 18, Mark 13:24-32

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, on November 6th our diocese celebrated her 46th anniversary. To mark the occasion, Bishop Wack released “Sharing the Gift,” his first pastoral letter. In this letter, he shares his vision for the diocese moving forward and challenges the faithful to evangelize. “Evangelization” may sound intimidating, but it is simply a way to awaken in people’s heart a love of God and an adherence to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Last weekend, hard copies of the pastoral letter were distributed to parishioners. I kindly ask you to visit [ptdiocese.org/pastoral-letter](http://ptdiocese.org/pastoral-letter) for an online copy.

The pastoral letter is divided into nine sections: introduction, biblical basis for evangelization, early church, origins of christendom, the death of christendom, renewal, what does evangelization look like today, evangelizing in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee, Mary and the saints who will guide and assist us. We shall be impelling this pastoral letter in our parish and each parishioner is invited to fully be part of it. “I humbly ask everyone in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee to read the letter, pray with it and put into practice Jesus’ call- ‘Go and make disciples of all nations...’ (Matthew 28:19).”- Bishop William Wack.

November 7 to 13 marked the National Vocation Awareness week. This annual week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States promotes vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life through prayer and education, and to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of these particular vocations. We give thanks to God our Father, for caring men and women to serve in his Son’s Kingdom as priests, deacons and consecrated persons. We ask the Holy Spirit to help others to respond generously and courageously to God’s call. May our community of faith, St. Eugene Catholic Mission and Student Center support vocations of sacrificial love in our youth and young adults. Amen.

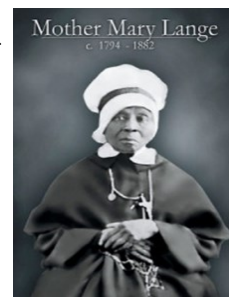

**Elizabeth Clarisse Lange (1784-1882)**

We do not know very much about Elizabeth Lange’s early life. Recent research points to Santiago de Cuba as her birthplace. By 1813 she was living in Baltimore and used her own money and home to educate children of color. Elizabeth, with a friend, Marie Magdelaine Balas, offered free education to children in their home in the Fells Point area of the city. Early in 1828 Providence intervened through the person of Reverend James Hector Joubert, S.S. who, encouraged by Archbishop James Whitfield, presented Elizabeth Lange with the challenge to start a school for girls of color. On July 2, 1829, Elizabeth and three other women pronounced promises of poverty, chastity, and obedience to Archbishop Whitfield and the chosen superior. Elizabeth, is considered the founder and first superior of the Oblate Sisters of Providence, henceforth was known as Sister Mary. She was superior general from 1829 to 1832, and again from 1835 to 1841. When considering the works of Mother Mary Lange and her sisters also established an orphanage, a widow’s home, provided spiritual direction, religious education classes and vocational training. The early Sisters did home visiting and conducted night schools so black adults could learn to read and write. She helped to nurse the sick during the Cholera Epidemic in the early 1830’s and in the mid 1840’s. Lange died February 3, 1882. In 1991 William Cardinal Keeler, the then Archbishop of Baltimore, with the approval of Rome, officially opened the cause for her canonization.



No sabemos mucho sobre los primeros años de vida de Elizabeth Lange. Investigaciones recientes apuntan a Santiago de Cuba como su lugar de nacimiento. Para 1813 vivía en Baltimore y usaba su propio dinero y su hogar para educar a los niños de color. Elizabeth, con una amiga, Marie Magdelaine Balas, ofreció educación gratuita a los niños en su hogar en el área de Fells Point de la ciudad. A principios de 1828, Providence intervino a través de la persona del reverendo James Hector Joubert, S.S., quien, alentado por el arzobispo James Whitfield, le presentó a Elizabeth Lange el desafío de comenzar una escuela para niñas de color. El 2 de julio de 1829, Elizabeth y otras tres mujeres pronunciaron promesas de pobreza, castidad y obediencia al arzobispo Whitfield y al superior elegido. Elizabeth, es considerada la fundadora y primera superiora de las Hermanas Oblatas de la Providencia, en adelante fue conocida como la Hermana Mary. Fue superior general de 1829 a 1832, y nuevamente de 1835 a 1841. Al considerar los trabajos de la Madre Mary Lange y sus hermanas, también establecieron un orfanato, el hogar de una viuda, proporcionaron dirección espiritual, clases de educación religiosa y capacitación vocacional. Las primeras hermanas hicieron visitas a domicilio y organizaron escuelas nocturnas para que los adultos negros pudieran aprender a leer y escribir. Ella ayudó a cuidar a los enfermos durante la epidemia de cólera a principios de 1830 y mediados de 1840. Lange murió el 3 de febrero de 1882. En 1991, el cardenal William Keeler, entonces arzobispo de Baltimore, con la aprobación de Roma, abrió oficialmente la causa de su canonización. 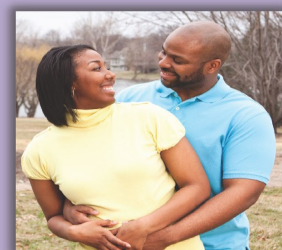
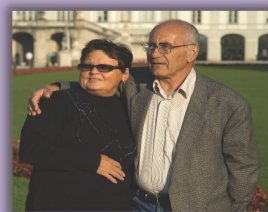

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, el 6 de noviembre nuestra diócesis celebró su 46 aniversario. Para conmemorar la ocasión, el obispo Wack publicó “Compartiendo el don”, su primera carta pastoral. En esta carta, comparte su visión para que la diócesis avance y desafía a los fieles a evangelizar. 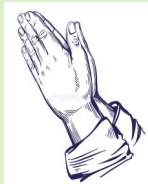
