From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, November 28th, 2021 – First Sunday of Advent - Cycle C

Sharing the Gifts

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Greetings in the Lord! As I celebrate my fourth anniversary as your bishop, I wish to express in this Pastoral Letter my deepest hope for the Church (that is, the People of God – us). The longer I serve as a priest and bishop, the truth of this statement becomes more evident: The Church exists to evangelize! Put simply, if we believe that Jesus Christ suffered and died for us and rose again to set us free from sin and death, we are compelled to share that Good News with everyone around us.

We are living in challenging times, to be sure. Our world, our families and even our beloved Church, is experiencing a great deal of division, acrimony and confusion. It seems as though we are condemned to exist in a world where everyone either agrees with us (and thus are on our side) or disagrees with us (and thus are to be shunned – or, worse: treated as ‘enemies’). However, there is a way out: embracing and sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ, who said, “Seek first the kingdom of God ...” (Mt 6:33) A focus on sharing the Good News not only helps us to address the many challenges we face, it is something very positive and hopeful.

Is there anything more hopeful and joyful than knowing that in Christ Jesus we are loved, redeemed, and are given the promise of eternal life? If we truly believe that, we can say with St. Paul: “If God is for us, who can be against us?” (Rom 8:31)

Sisters and brothers, why are we downcast today? Why does there exist so much anger and outrage within ourselves and in the world today? I believe that we have forgotten the truth of the Gospel: God the Father sent his Son into the world to save us from our sins, and God also gave us the Holy Spirit to lead us and guide us. Thus, we are invited to share in God’s divine life even now. Since that is so, what could possibly afflict us? Jesus says to us, “Do not let your hearts be troubled ... Have faith in me.” (Jn 14:1)

One of my (new) favorite passages from the Bible comes from the Book of Zechariah. The prophet lived and ministered in times of struggle and confusion, not unlike our own day and age. Yet he was absolutely convinced of God’s ultimate plan to bring salvation to all of creation. One of his prophecies ends with great hope in the coming of the Messiah, and the response of God’s beloved people: “In those days, ten people from nations of every language will take hold, yes, will take hold of the cloak of every [Jew] and say, ‘Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you.’” (Zech 8:23)

May we live our faith well, confident in the glory that is ours in Jesus Christ, so that people around us may say the same thing: “Tell me about God, for I am sure that he is with you!” This is our task and our challenge. If we believe in the Good News, we must share it with everyone we encounter.

I hope in this Letter to instruct, exhort, and then join you in living as a missionary disciple of our Lord. I humbly ask everyone in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee to read it and pray with it. My prayer is that all of us – as families, as parishes and as individuals – will put this teaching into practice and heed Jesus’ call: “Go and make disciples of all nations ...” (Mt. 28:19)

Palabras del Párroco

Domingo, 28 de noviembre de 2021 - Primer domingo de Adviento - Ciclo C

Compartir el Don

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas: ¡Saludos en el Señor! Al celebrar mi cuarto aniversario como su obispo, deseo expresar en esta carta pastoral mi más profunda esperanza para la Iglesia (es decir, nosotros, el Pueblo de Dios). Cuanto más tiempo sirvo como sacerdote y obispo, la verdad de esta afirmación se hace más evidente: ¡la Iglesia existe para evangelizar! Dicho de manera sencilla, si creemos que Jesucristo sufrió y murió por nosotros, y resucitó para liberarnos del pecado y de la muerte, estamos obligados a compartir esa buena nueva con todos los que nos rodean.

No cabe duda de que vivimos tiempos difíciles. Nuestro mundo, nuestras familias, e incluso nuestra amada Iglesia, están experimentando gran división, amargura y confusión. Parece como si estuviéramos condenados a existir en un mundo en el que todos están de acuerdo con nosotros (y, por lo tanto, están de nuestro lado), o están en desacuerdo con nosotros (y, por consiguiente, deben ser rechazados o, peor aún, tratados como "enemigos"). Sin embargo, hay una salida: acoger y compartir el Evangelio de Jesucristo, que dice: "Busquen primero el Reino de Dios..." (Mt 6, 33). Concentrarse en compartir la buena nueva no solo nos ayuda a tratar los numerosos desafíos a los que nos enfrentamos, sino que es algo muy positivo y esperanzador.

¿Hay algo que brinde más esperanza y gozo que saber que en Cristo Jesús somos amados, redimidos, y se nos da la promesa de la vida eterna? Si de verdad lo creemos, podemos decir con San Pablo: "Si Dios está con nosotros, ¿quién estará contra nosotros?" (Rom 8, 31).

Hermanas y hermanos, ¿por qué nos encontramos desanimados en estos días? ¿Por qué existe tanta ira e indignación en nosotros mismos y en el mundo de hoy? Creo que hemos olvidado la verdad del Evangelio: Dios Padre envió a su Hijo al mundo para salvarnos de nuestros pecados, y Dios también nos dio el Espíritu Santo para orientarnos y guiarnos. Por consiguiente, se nos invita a participar en la vida divina de Dios también en este momento. Si es así, ¿qué podría afligirnos? Jesús nos dice: "No se turbe su corazón... crean también en mí" (Jn 14, 1).

Uno de mis (nuevos) pasajes favoritos de la Biblia se encuentra en el Libro de Zacarías. El profeta vivió y ejerció su ministerio en tiempos de dificultades y confusión no muy distintos a los nuestros. Sin embargo, estaba absolutamente convencido del plan definitivo de Dios para llevar la salvación a toda la creación. Una de sus profecías concluye con gran esperanza en la venida del Mesías, y la respuesta del pueblo amado de Dios: "En esos días diez hombres, de distinta nacionalidad cada uno, agarrarán por el manto a un judío, suplicándole: 'Queremos ir con ustedes, pues hemos oído decir que Dios está con ustedes'" (Za 8, 23).

Que vivamos bien nuestra fe, confiados en la gloria que nos pertenece en Jesucristo, para que quienes nos rodean puedan decir lo mismo: "¡Háblenme de Dios, porque estamos seguros de que está con ustedes!" Este es nuestro responsabilidad y nuestro desafío. Si creemos en la buena nueva, debemos compartirla con todos los que encontremos.

En esta carta espero instruir, exhortar, y luego unirme a ustedes para vivir como un discípulo misionero de nuestro Señor. Pido humildemente a todos en la Diócesis de Pensacola-Tallahassee que la lean y oren con ella. Mi oración es que todos nosotros —como familias, como parroquias y como individuos— pongamos en práctica esta enseñanza y respondamos al llamado de Jesús: "Vayan, pues, y hagan que todos los pueblos sean mis discípulos..." (Mt 28, 19)

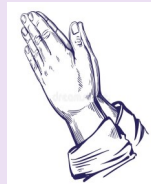
