**From the Pastor's Desk...**

**Sunday, November 7th, 2021 – XXXII Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Readings:** 1 Kings 17:10-16, Psalm 146 “Praise the Lord, my soul!”, Hebrews 9:24-28, Mark 12:38-44 or 12:41-44

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, November is designated as Black Catholic History Month. It is the month we celebrate the contributions of people of African descent. On November 09, 1952, St. Eugene Catholic Mission and Student Center was opened to serve FAMU and the surrounding African American community. Today we celebrate 69 years of God's blessing and graces. Indeed “We've come this far by faith”. It is through the grace of God and the efforts of many people: many priests, parishioners, friends, family and benefactors. We sincerely thank each one of you as we recall our history, celebrate the present blessings and plan for the future. We salute you all. In a special way honor Mr. George Thompson for his contributions and exemplary life over the years. Mr. George's favorite saying is " Don't worry, God is in control !" God is in control of our history.

This weekend also marks 46th anniversary of the establishment of the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee, Bishop Wack has released his first Pastoral Letter, Sharing the Gift. The gift is our faith, the gospel, our salvation in Jesus Christ, our time, talents and treasure.

“We are living in challenging times, to be sure. Our world, our families and even our beloved Church, is experiencing a great deal of division, acrimony and confusion. It seems as though we are condemned to exist in a world where everyone either agrees with us (and thus are on our side) or disagrees with us (and thus are to be shunned – or, worse: treated as ‘enemies’). However, there is a way out: embracing and sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ, who said, “Seek first the kingdom of God ...” (Mt 6:33) A focus on sharing the Good News not only helps us to address the many challenges we face, it is something very positive and hopeful” (Sharing the gift).

St. Eugene is a rich and vibrant community, made up of people from many races, ages, and languages. We thank the Lord for how far he has brought us and as we look to the future we say “Don't worry, God is in control”. May the Lord bless us, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, noviembre está designado como el Mes de la Historia de los Católicos de Raza Negra. Es el mes en que celebramos las contribuciones de los afrodescendientes. El 9 de noviembre de 1952, se abrió el Misión Católica y Centro de Estudiantil San Eugenio para servir a FAMU y la comunidad afroamericana circundante. 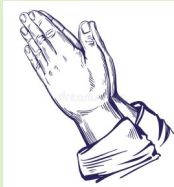
