Milagros eucarísticos en latinoamerica

En muchos lugares alrededor del mundo se han tenido Milagros eucarísticos y America latino no es la excepcion. Cinco países han sido escenario de estos Milagros: México, Venezuela, Colombia, Argentina y Perú. Aquí pueden encontrar el de México, esta información fue obtenida de ACI Prensa

El 12 de octubre de 2014 el Obispo de Chilpancingo-Chilapa, Mons. Alejo Zavala, anunció el reconocimiento del milagro eucarístico ocurrido en Tixtla el 21 de octubre de 2006.

En la carta, el Obispo anuncia que "esta manifestación nos lleva a un maravilloso signo del amor de Dios que confirma la presencia Real de Jesús en la Eucaristía... En mi papel de Obispo de la Diócesis reconozco el carácter sobrenatural de la serie de acontecimientos descubiertos en la hostia sangrante de Tixtla. Declaro el caso como un "signo divino". El milagro consistió en una sustancia rojiza que fluyó de una hostia consagrada durante una Misa. Tras las investigaciones científicas realizadas por el Dr. Castañón Gómez, se descubrió que la sustancia rojiza correspondía a sangre con hemoglobina y ADN de origen humano; que provenía del interior de la hostia; y que contenía tipo de sangre AB similar al hallado en la hostia de Lancia y la Sábana Santa de Turín.

Las conclusiones de los científicos y el comité teológico fueron que el acontecimiento "no tiene una explicación natural, ni origen paranormal y que no puede imputarse a la manipulación del enemigo".

Eucharistic miracles in Latin America

Eucharistic miracles have been held in many places around the world and Latin America is no exception. Five countries have been the scene of these Miracles: Mexico, Venezuela, Colombia, Argentina and Peru. Here you can find the one from Mexico, this information was obtained from ACI Prensa On October 12, 2014, the Bishop of Chilpancingo-Chilapa, Mons. Alejo Zavala, announced the recognition of the Eucharistic miracle that occurred in Tixtla on October 21, 2006. In the letter, the Bishop announces that "this manifestation leads us to a wonderful sign of God's love that confirms the Real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist... In my role as Bishop of the Diocese, I recognize the supernatural character of the series of events discovered in the bleeding host of Tixtla. I declare the case as a "divine sign." The miracle consisted of a reddish substance that flowed from a consecrated host during a Mass. After the scientific investigations carried out by Dr. Castañón Gómez, it was discovered that the reddish substance corresponded to blood with hemoglobin and DNA of human origin; that it came from inside the host; and that it contained AB blood type similar to that found on the Lancia host and the Shroud of Turin. The conclusions of the scientists and the theological committee were that the event "does not have a natural explanation, nor a paranormal origin and that it cannot be attributed to the manipulation of the enemy."

From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, October 10th, 2021 – XXVIII Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Wisdom 7:7-11, Psalm 90 “Fill us with your love, O Lord, and we will sing for joy!”, Hebrews 4:12-13, Mark 10:17-30 or 10:17-27

My dear brothers and sisters, this Sunday Bishop William Wack celebrates the welcome mass for our students, faculty and staff. In the Mass we shall honor the Late Dr. Frederick S. Humphries, Sr., who passed away on June 24, 2021, leaving a legacy of Black exceptionalism that remains the envy of academia. The late Dr Humphries had an extraordinary impact on many thousands of Black Students and their families.

Dr Humphries attended the Florida A&M College, which became a university during the time he was a student. He graduated with honors with a degree in chemistry from FAMU. Dr. Humphries began his role as a member of the “First Evers” as the first African American to earn a doctorate in physical chemistry from the University of Pittsburgh.

After teaching chemistry at FAMU in 1974, he became president of Tennessee State University (TSU). When he returned to his beloved FAMU as president in 1985, it was the beginning of a remarkable journey that would elevate the university and Historically Black Colleges and Universities to their rightful status as valuable institutions of higher learning. He was defiant and unrelenting when advancing FAMU.

When Dr. Humphries came back as the president of FAMU, St. Eugene Catholic Mission and students Center was closed. Due to his effort, St Eugene was reopened not just for the parishioners, faculty and staff but so that the church can nurture the faith and spiritual development of the students. He had an extraordinary impact on thousands of Black students and their families.

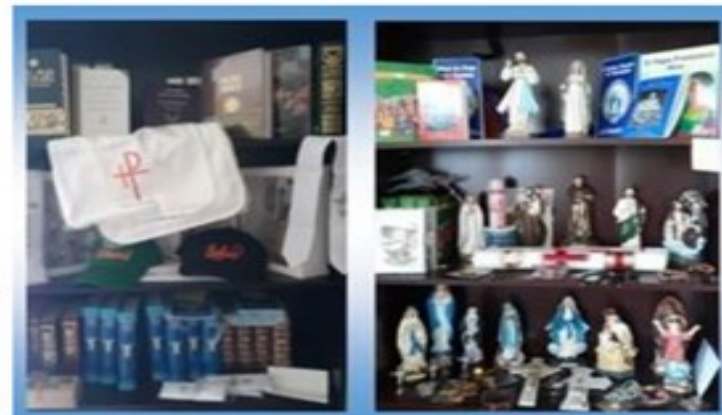
Dr. Humphries was preceded in death by his beloved parents, Thornton G. Humphries, Sr. and Minnie Henry Humphries; his brother, Thornton G. Humphries, Jr. and sister, Mona Humphries Bailey. He was married to the late Antoinette McTurner Humphries. He is survived by their three children, Frederick S. Humphries, Jr., (Kim Sheftall) of Washington, D.C.; Robin Tanya Humphries Watson of Orlando, Fla.; Laurence Anthony Humphries (Carnesha Allen) of Houston, Texas; and eight grandchildren and a host of other family members and friends.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas, este domingo el obispo William Wack celebra la misa de bienvenida para nuestros estudiantes, profesores y personal. En la misa honraremos al difunto Dr. Frederick S. Humphries, Sr., quien falleció el 24 de junio de 2021, dejando un legado de excepcionalismo negro que sigue siendo la envidia de la academia. El difunto Dr. Humphries tuvo un impacto extraordinario en muchos miles de estudiantes afroamericanos y sus familias.

El Dr. Humphries asistió al Florida A&M College, que se convirtió en universidad durante su época de estudiante. Se graduó con honores con una licenciatura en química de FAMU. El Dr. Humphries comenzó su papel como miembro de los "First Evers" como el primer afroamericano en obtener un doctorado en química física de la Universidad de Pittsburgh.

Después de enseñar química en FAMU en 1974, se convirtió en presidente de la Universidad Estatal de Tennessee (TSU). Cuando regresó a su amada FAMU como presidente en 1985, fue el comienzo de un viaje extraordinario que elevaría a la universidad y a los Colegios y Universidades Históricamente Afroamericano a su estatus legítimo como valiosas instituciones de educación superior. Fue desafiante e implacable al avanzar FAMU.

Cuando el Dr. Humphries regresó como presidente de FAMU, la Misión Católica y Centro Estudiantil San Eugenio estaban cerrados. Debido a su esfuerzo por su parte, San Eugenio fue reabierto no solo para los feligreses, la facultad y el personal, sino para que la iglesia pudiera nutrir la fe y el desarrollo espiritual de los estudiantes. Tuvo un impacto extraordinario en miles de estudiantes afroamericanos y sus familias.

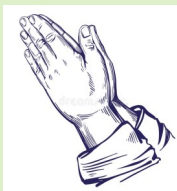
