From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, October 24th, 2021 – XXX Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Jeremiah 31:7-9, Ps 126 “The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy”, Hebrews 5:1-6, Mark 10:46-52

Today we celebrate World Mission Sunday. It is our yearly opportunity to honor our life as Catholics through the special call we received at Baptism to be missionaries. It also reminds us of the service offered by the Church's missionaries in bearing Christ's message of salvation to all people in all lands. In line with this you can do three things to help a missionary to carry out his or her work, you can pray for a missionary, you can send a word of encouragement to a missionary, and you can support the work of a missionary.

The Gospel for this Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time is wonderfully appropriate in revealing the life-changing joy that can come to us as followers of our Lord and Redeemer. We meet Jesus as He is traveling with His disciples and a crowd of people who want to stay in His company as long as possible. They pass a blind man sitting by the side of the road begging. His name is Bartimaeus. Obviously, he has already heard of Jesus' message and miracles; so, he shouts out, acknowledging Jesus as the Son of David and asking for His pity. The people try to quiet him; after all, he is loud and annoying and trying to get Jesus' attention. But Jesus hears Bartimaeus and tells the others to send him forward. “He threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus. Jesus said to him... ‘What do you want Me to do for you?’ The blind man replied to Him, ‘Master, I want to see.’ Jesus told him, ‘Go on your way; your faith has saved you.’ Immediately he received his sight and followed Him on the way” (Mark 10:50-52).

This man, a blind beggar, would have been of little account to his neighbors. Yet he was able to see more clearly than many who followed Jesus. He already believed that He was the Messiah and trusted Him to heal his blindness. The way he jumped up to run to our Lord and then instantly followed Him when he received his sight reveal just how much Bartimaeus rejoiced, not only in having his eyes opened, but also in his faith. Unlike many who believe, he did not hesitate to express his gratitude with exuberance. Let us willingly show our belief in the Christ who heals spiritual blindness as joyfully as Bartimaeus – for all the world to see.

On this World Mission Sunday, let us also “speak” of our faith, through our prayers and financial help to the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. Our generosity on this Sunday, combined with what is offered in churches and chapels around the globe, join us to the efforts of missionaries who proclaim the Gospel and serve the poor.

Domingo, 24 de octubre de 2021 - XXX Domingo Ordinario - Ciclo B

Lectura: Jeremías 31, 7-9, Salmo 125 "Grandes cosas has hecho por nosotros, Señor", Hebreos 5, 1-6, Marcos 10, 46-52

Hoy celebramos el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones. Es nuestra oportunidad anual de honrar nuestra vida como católicos a través del llamado especial que recibimos en el Bautismo para ser misioneros. También nos recuerda el servicio ofrecido por los misioneros de la Iglesia al llevar el mensaje de salvación de Cristo a todas las personas en todos los países. De acuerdo con esto, puede hacer tres cosas para ayudar a un misionero a llevar a cabo su obra de ella, puede orar por un misionero, puede enviar una palabra de aliento a un misionero y puede apoyar el trabajo de un misionero. El Evangelio para este trigésimo domingo de tiempo ordinario es maravillosamente apropiado para revelar el gozo transformador que puede llegar a nosotros como seguidores de nuestro Señor y Redentor. Nos encontramos con Jesús mientras viaja con sus discípulos de él y una multitud de personas que quieren permanecer en su compañía el mayor tiempo posible. Pasan junto a un ciego sentado a un lado del camino pidiendo limosna. Su nombre es Bartimeo. Evidentemente, ya ha oído hablar del mensaje y los milagros de Jesús; por eso, grita, reconociendo a Jesús como el Hijo de David y pidiendo su piedad de él. La gente trata de calmarlo; después de todo, es ruidoso y molesto y trata de llamar la atención de Jesús. Pero Jesús escucha a Bartimeo y les dice a los demás que lo envíen. "Se echó a un lado su manto, se levantó de un salto y se acercó a Jesús. Jesús le dijo ... "¿Qué quieres que haga por ti?" El ciego le respondió: "Maestro, quiero ver". Jesús le dijo: "Sigue tu camino; tu fe te ha salvado. 'En seguida recobré la vista de él y lo seguí por el camino'" (Marcos 10: 50-52).

Este hombre, un mendigo ciego, habría sido de poca importancia para sus vecinos. Sin embargo, pudo ver más claramente que muchos que siguieron a Jesús. Él ya creía que Él era el Mesías y confiaba en Él para sanar su ceguera. La forma en que saltó para correr hacia nuestro Señor y luego instantáneamente lo siguió cuando lo vio revela cuánto se regocijó Bartimeo, no solo por haberle abierto los ojos, sino también por la fe que tenía en él. A diferencia de muchos que creen, él no dudó en expresar su gratitud hacia él con exuberancia. Demostremos de buena gana nuestra fe en el Cristo que sana la ceguera espiritual con tanta alegría como Bartimeo, para que todo el mundo lo vea.

En este Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, también "hablemos" de nuestra fe, a través de nuestras oraciones y ayuda financiera a la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe. Nuestra generosidad este domingo, combinada con lo que se ofrece en las iglesias y capillas de todo el mundo, nos une a los esfuerzos de los misioneros que proclaman el Evangelio y sirven a los pobres.

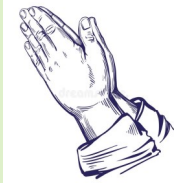

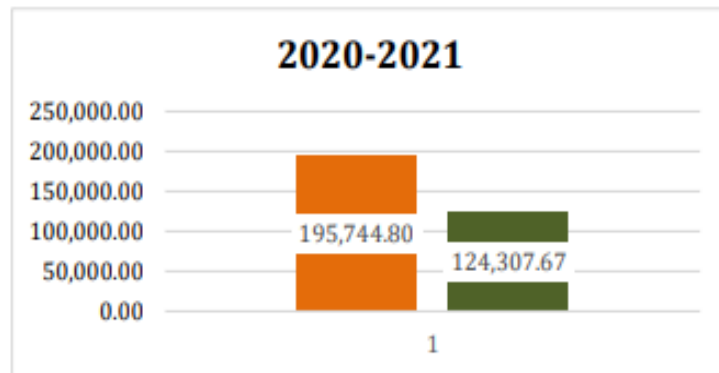
I am pleased to present the 2020-2021 Stewardship Annual Report.

The report highlights the important activities accomplished by the friends and families of Saint Eugene Catholic Mission and Student Center. The Inner workings of volunteers spans our ministries, committees, programs, and services that have touched the lives of our parishioners. Thank you for answering God's call to serve our church by giving unselfishly of your time, talent and treasure.

The following is a summary of Saint Eugene's income and expenses for the fiscal year of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

Income:

- Fifty-nine percent of our income comes from offertory.
- Twenty-nine percent comes from other income such as Gross Fundraisers.
- Twelve percent comes from donations and prayer requests.

Expenses:

- Thirty-five percent of our expenses come from clergy salary.
- Eight percent is for office administration.
- Thirty-two percent is for general maintenance such as utilities and general insurance.
- The lay salaries constitute eighteen percent of the expenses.
- The remaining seven percent is spent on ministries and church programs.

Fundraising activities such as Food Sales and Religious Articles brought funds to Saint Eugene and allowed us to cover expenses.

Under the guidance and leadership of Fr Paschal Chester, SVD and the support of the friends and families of Saint Eugene, the following major improvements were completed:

- Painted the inside of the church
- Installed carpet in the church
- Installed a security system in the office and church
- Replaced and renovated the storage sheds
- Trees and debris removal
- Office flooring and paint
- Constructed cabinets for Religious Education

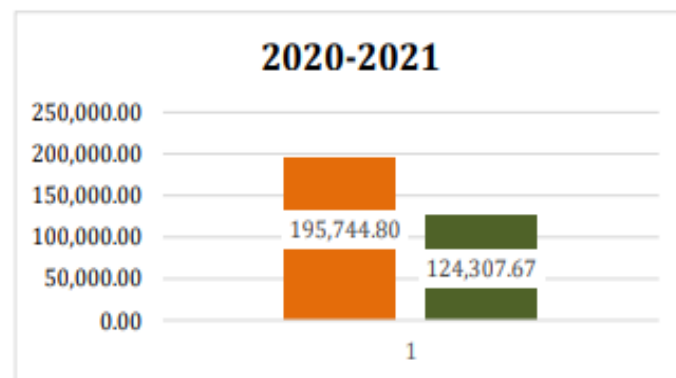
Me complace presentar el Informe anual de administración 2020-2021.
